Four Steps in Creating a Team, Circle Ministry Proposal

Step One. Writing the Proposal

The person proposing the team, or group opportunity submits a written proposal to the Leader Champions. The person proposing a new project submits a written proposal to the Board of Trustees. The proposal forms are included in this policy.

Step Two. Evaluating the Proposal of a New Team, Circle, or Ministry

The Leader Champions or Board of Trustees meet to evaluate the proposal. If it is approved, a Leader Champion is assigned to interview the team, circle or team leader to clarify points, to discuss the leadership role according to the Care Structure and Metamodel, and to establish accountability for the project or team. If the proposal does not seem to be a match, the team leader or project leader will be notified by one of the Leader Champions.

Step Three. Commissioning the Project

When the proposal is approved by the Board of Trustees, the assigned Board of Trustees member will contact the leader for the implementation. The Board of Trustees member will meet monthly with the Project Coordinator. The new project will be placed on the master calendar. The congregation will be notified in the weekly newsletter and/or Sunday service announcements if applicable.

Step Four. Tracking the Project (for projects only)

Tracking of Project: The Project Leader is to keep track of the progress of the project, oversee costs, ensure accountability for the project, and communicate this to the assigned Board of Trustees.
